• Candidates who are unsuccessful in the theory or practical part of a subject/s shall answer only unsuccessful part of the subject(s).

• PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

Practical Examinations will be conducted in various categories for unsuccessful candidates in practical only at the intimation from the concerned Heads of the institutions at the time of filling of application forms vide separate letter. The dates for the same will be communicated later on.

• JUNE EXAMINATION

Secondary Schools may refer to circular No.55 dated 07/12/16 wherein students will be allowed to answer all subjects provided they have answered the respective Xth Goa Board Examination previously. No fresh student will be allowed to answer the June Examination.

Similarly students who have withdrawn their application forms for the preceding April Examination will not be allowed for the June Examination.

• IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

Candidates who have passed the examination but desire to improve in a subject/s may also apply, under the Scheme of improvement. A Candidate is allowed two chances for improvement within a period of two years of passing the S.S.C. Examination. As one time permission candidates who have passed S.S.C. Examination in March/April 2017 are also eligible for this scheme.

All Schools should deposit the examination fees either by cash /crossed cheque drawn payable to Secretary, Goa Board of Secondary and higher Secondary Education, Alto Betim, only in any branch of **Central Bank of India**. - 5. While depositing cash /Cheque please inform the respective branch about Name of the School, address, School Index Number, fee details are to be filled on the bank slip without fail.
- 6. Bank Counterfoil should be submitted along with the examination application forms at the Goa Board office.
