As you are aware, the Jalianwala Bagh Massacre also known as Amritsar Massacre took place on 13<sup>th</sup> April 1919 when troops of the British Indian Army under the command of Brigadier - General Dyer, fired rifles into a crowd of Indians who had gathered in Jalianwala Bagh, Amritsar, Punjab.

The civilians had assembled for peaceful protest to condemn the arrest and deportation of two national leaders Satya Pal and Saifuddin Kitchlew.

Government of India has decided to mark the remembrance of 100 years of historical of Jalianwala Bagh Massacre.

When we observe 100 years of the horrific Jalianwala Bagh Massacre, India pays tribute to all those martyred on that fateful day. It took nobel laureate Rabindranath Tagore to capture the full import of the outrage at Jalianwala Bagh, in his letter of protest renouncing the knighthood conferred on him.
